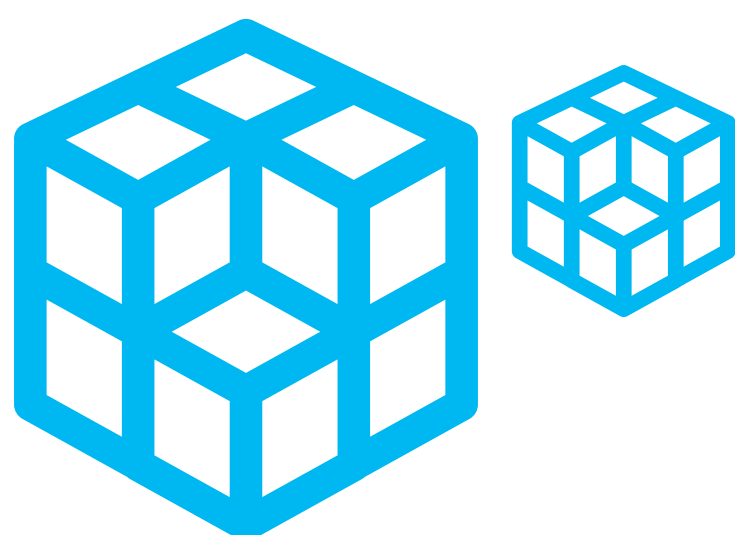

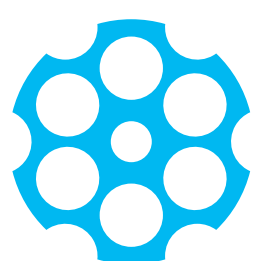
## KEY RESULTS: JULY 2013 – AUGUST 2014

Focal point on Tracing established by decision of Ministry of Internal Affairs (MoIA), trained and operational within Kosovo Police



Delivery of Tracing database to Kosovo Police and linkage to all evidence rooms of KP including Border police, MoIA and KFA

All representatives (72 EA) trained in tracing



Public Destruction of 770 weapons and 1360 spare parts

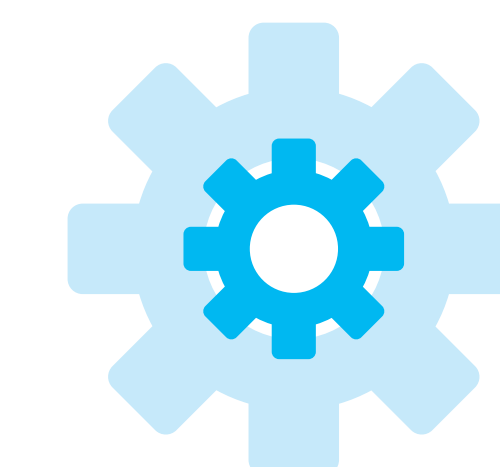
Delivery of Cartwin Pro (ammunition encyclopedia – software) databases to all police regions
