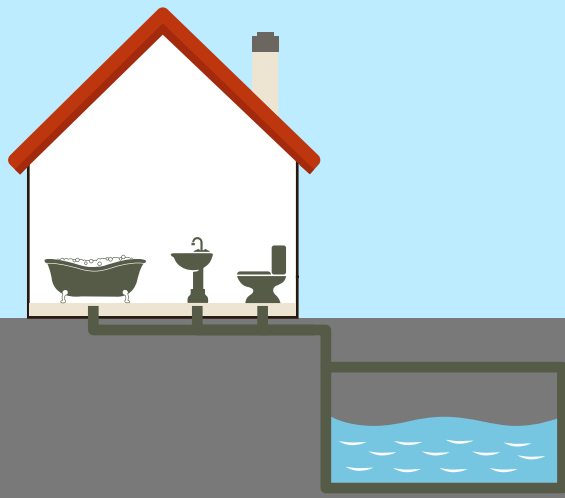


TECHNOLOGIES – the main driver of changes



WHILE ONLY 1% OF RURAL POPULATION HAS ACCESS TO PUBLIC SEWERAGE SYSTEM, **33,2%** OF VILLAGE INHABITANTS BUILT THEIR OWN SEWERAGE SYSTEMS.

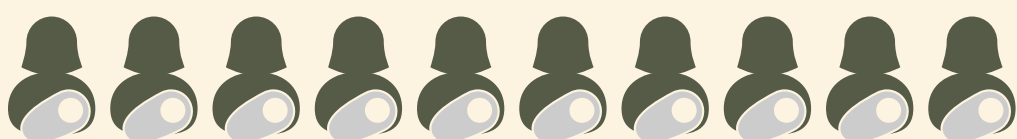
