(3) Committed (or obligated) funds are those for which projects have been approved or agreements/contracts have been signed or are in the process of being transferred/dispensed. Committed funds are exclusive of disbursed funds. The tally total of the amount disbursed and committed in 2010 may be greater than the amount allocated to 2010 as donors have committed funds that they plan to disburse in 2011.

(4) Disbursed funds are those that have been transferred to an implementing partner (e.g., the Government of Haiti, an NGO or other non-state service provider).

(6) Funds from the United States government recorded as being committed have been obligated. This means that the funds are guaranteed to the implementing partner which can begin implementation.
