Sustainable, resilient and inclusive growth, and structural transformation

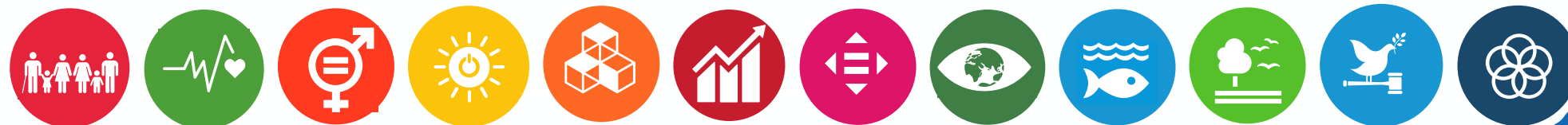
