



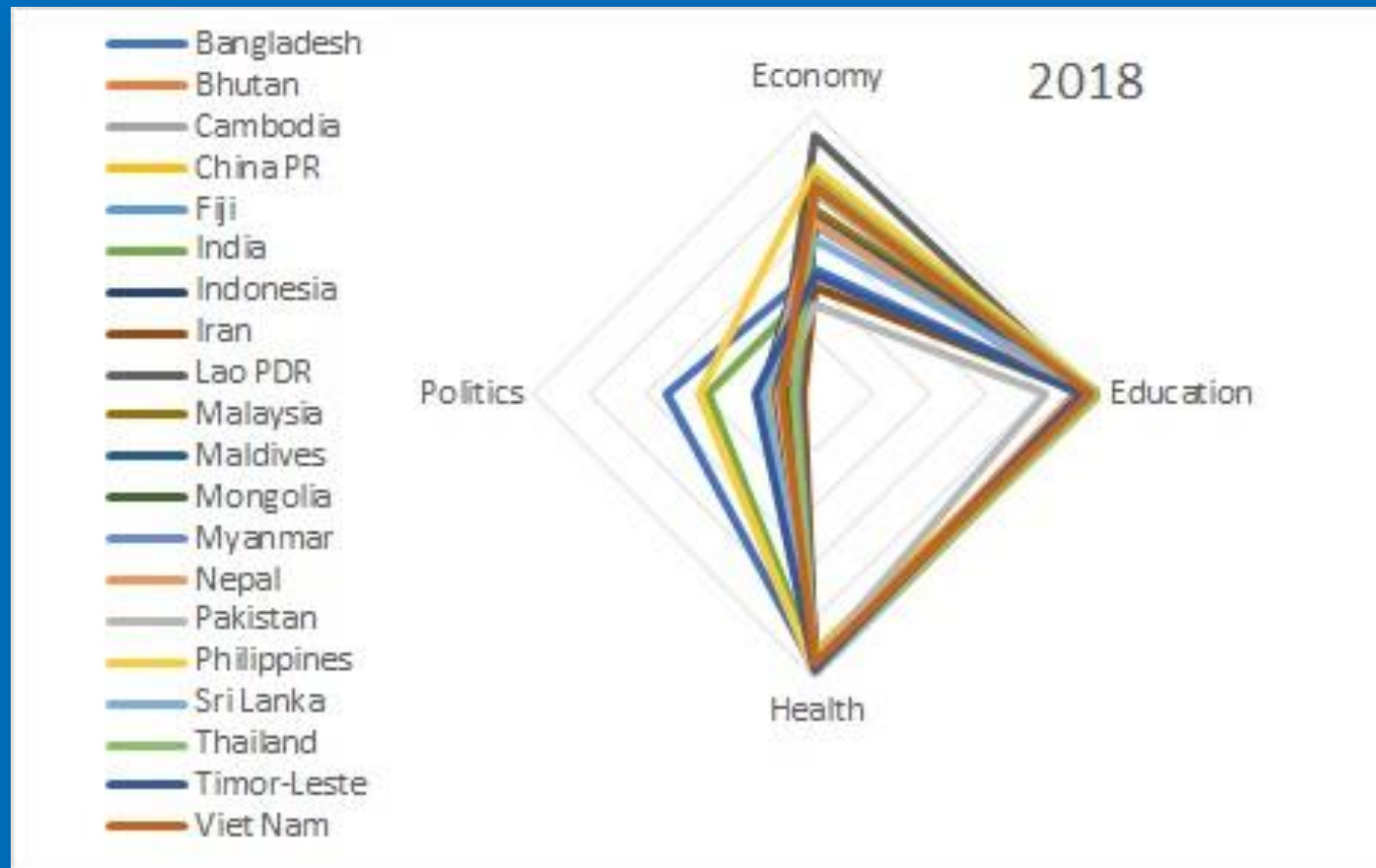

Gender Gap Across Asia and the Pacific



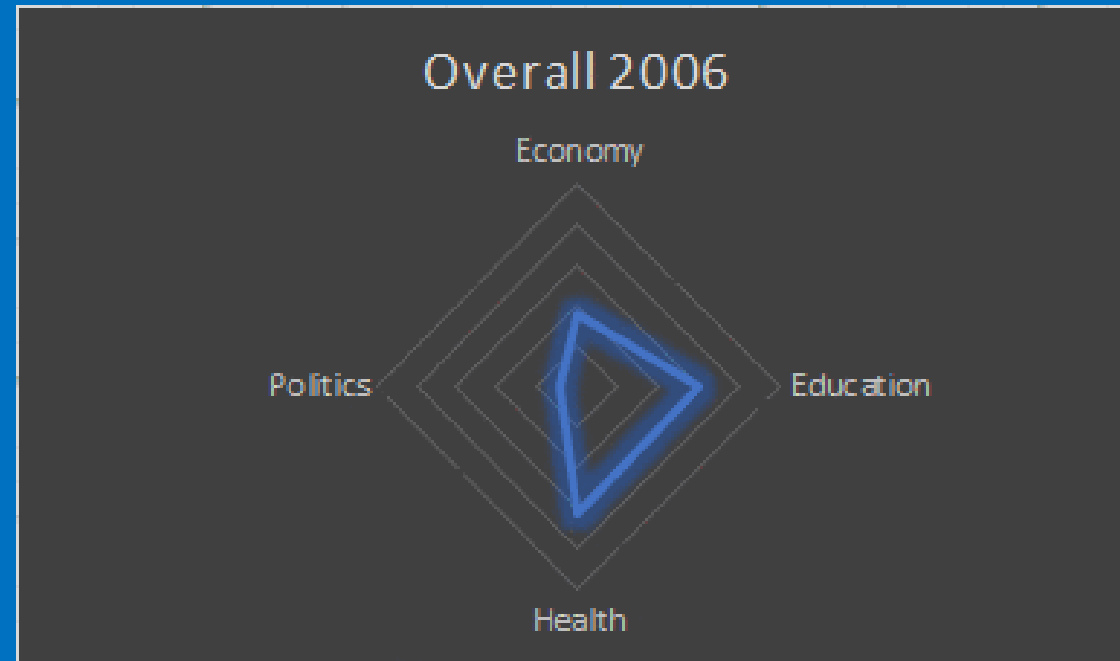

Gender-Based Violence

Persistent Equality Challenges

SOUTH ASIA

Severe Food Insecurity

1/3 of women in reproductive age are undernourished

Less than **1/5** parliamentarians are women

Unpaid care and domestic work

Women do **11 times** as much as men

Women in formal jobs earn much less than men

Gender wage gaps range from **1,5% to 49,6%**



LABOR FORCE PARTICIPATION

Declining female labor force participation
56% in 1990 to 49% in 2013

Poverty

For every 100 men, there are 104 women living below the poverty line

Only 53% of partnered women

freely make their own decisions about sexual relations, contraceptive use and health care

THE 4 MAIN ISSUES AFFECTING ASIA-PACIFIC (A-P)

AGEING

By 2050,
25% of the population
are expected to be
senior citizens.

URBANIZATION

In 2015, nearly half of the
population lived in A-P cities.
By 2050, this is expected to
increase to nearly 2/3.

**PERSISTENT
INEQUALITY**

YOUTH UNEMPLOYMENT

Of the 358 million global youth
who are not in education,
employment or training,
220 million are from A-P.

CLIMATE CHANGE

A-P is the most
vulnerable region to
climate change risks.
